One building has been demolished, and another will be totally rebuilt. During this COVID season, the leaders of this church have, themselves, done all the paper and bureaucratic work for this project. They have also done the physical labor to prepare the buildings for the new project. This, without a pastor, who resigned and left the church many months ago and without this missionary being physically present due to COVID. We want to lift them up in prayer and thank God for **faithful men**, who love God and Christ's church. Without them, this project would have been dead in the water.
